The examiner will specify which techniques to be performed.	<u>Tachi-dori:</u> 5 free techniques. <u>Jo-dori:</u> 3 free technigues.
Yondan	Minimum four years practice after Sandan and recommendation from Shishiya sensei	The examiners requirements. Teaching to a group of students. Philosophy and principles underpinning the techniques should be explained. The student chooses 2-3 techniques and the examiner chooses 1-2 techniques.
